any Chapters in your area that would like someone from our Training Task Force to go in and train. I look forward to seeing everyone in November. Take care.

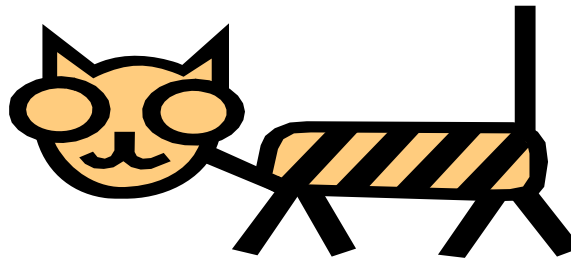

No joke - it's not funny.

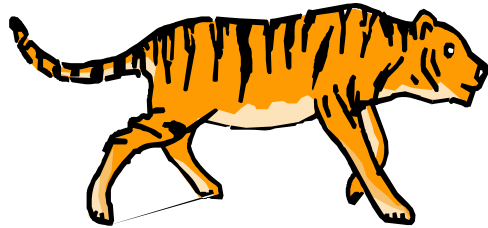
