

Please remember that these “standards” are to ensure the highest probability that the Nominee is not only qualified and deserving to be part of the “best of the best”, but that their information is accurate and complete. ALL information is to be filled out thoroughly and legibly, and all attachments provided as requested. If you have any questions, PLEASE ASK!!

The Terrible Tiger has requested that the application and payment be sent to the Tiger Tamer at least two weeks prior to the inductions.

The sponsor shall appear in a meeting 1 hour before the Tiger Executive Board meeting with the Tiger Tamer to review the application to ensure that everything is in order and properly funded.

Remember to be prepared to take care of the costs involved. If you are surprising your nominee he or she will still need to deal with the costs.

Here’s a quick review of the fees involved:

Application Fee is \$75 for all new members - includes the Annual pin & inductee designated shirt. Products Package is additional \$75 - pins & tickets inductee sells, thus making this money back! Life Membership pin is an additional \$75 at time of inductions, or \$100 after night of inductions.

After the inductions are complete, each new member is responsible for assisting in two areas:

1 – cleaning up the meeting room and

2 – assisting with CA JC I.D. Competitions, as needed. If the new member can not assist that weekend, they may get a substitute as long as they inform the Tiger Tamer of the change. If there are no I.D. competitions that weekend, then the new member must offer their assistance the next quarter.

On Sunday morning, at the JC General Assembly, all new members must wear their Tiger shirt, in order to be introduced. If there is no General Assembly that day, then the Tiger Tamer will provide alternate instructions. Those inductees not wearing their Tiger shirt should expect to pay a fine!

It is important to remember two things:

1 – the \$75 Application Fee is due with the application

2 – all Annual members **MUST** pay their Annual dues in May, regardless of when they became a member. If you joined in August, November, or February, renew in May or become a Life Member.

REQUIREMENTS

1. **Serve as a local Chapter President or State Officer (term State Officer excludes State Program Managers)**
2. **Has been a JC member, a minimum of 3 years, at least 1 of the 3 as a CA Jaycee.**
3. **Accumulate a minimum of 25 Points based on:**

1 point	Each complete year nominee has been a paid member
2 points	Local Chapter Director
3 points	Local Secretary, Treasurer, Vice President
5 points	Local State Director
10 points	Local President
5 points	State Program Chairman or State Program Manager
10 points	District Governor, Regional Director, State VP, State Officer
5 points	National Individual Development Competitor
5 points	Attended Tiger College in the previous two years
4. **On a *separate* sheet of paper, please:**
 - A. **Supply Service Record of the Nominee, based on the above points.**
 - B. **Explain why this person is worthy of being inducted into the CA Tigers.**
 - C. **Explain what type of training this person can provide to the CA Jaycees.**
 - D. **Provide signature verification of sponsor. Includes a *legible*, printed name in the signature box.**

Instructions for Sponsors

Leave as few blank spaces as possible on form. The sponsor signing below agrees to the following:

1. Sponsor MUST advise the Tiger Tamer or Pride Director of any candidates limitations such as allergies, alcohol tolerance, physical tolerance, physical limitations, etc.
2. Sponsor MUST meet with Tiger Tamer one hour before Tiger Exec Board Meeting, and MUST attend induction ceremony or provide a suitable replacement - they're in charge of the candidate.
3. Sponsor MUST provide or make arrangements for \$75 Application Fee to be submitted with application - Fee includes the Annual pin and the inductee designated shirt. Sponsor MUST also provide or make arrangements for initial purchases of the candidates Tiger products package - an additional \$75 - consists of pins and drawing tickets the inductee sells, thus making this money back. Life Membership pin is an additional \$75 at the time of inductions, or \$100 after night of inductions. Note: Annual Members must renew every May at \$25, or become a Life Member.
4. Sponsor must ensure the candidate will help clean the Tiger meeting room after inductions, and will help with the CAJC I.D. Competitions, as needed, or will provide a suitable replacement. If there are no competitions at that meeting, they must assist next quarter.
5. Sponsor's part in the induction includes administering the instructions of the Tiger Tamer, Terrible Tiger, and Past Terrible Tigers to the candidate.
6. The welfare of the candidate is the responsibility of the Sponsor. If the candidate needs anything, get it for them.
7. Additional instructions will be provided by the Tiger Tamer.
